#### Dear Student:

Each year, the San Joaquin Section of CASCWA provides scholarship awards to high school seniors, who will graduate during or at the conclusion of the 2015-2016 school year, and who attend schools in our region, which is comprised of these counties: *Fresno, Kern, Kings, Madera, Mariposa, Merced, Monterey, San Benito, San Luis Obispo, Stanislaus or Tulare.* 

The San Joaquin Section of CASCWA is pleased to announce the new scholarship award format and amount. Five (5) awards will be given out this year. Each successful applicant will be awarded an amount of \$1,000.00, and have the ability to receive an additional \$1,000.00 per year for up to three years depending upon the type of post high school program or school the Pupil is attending. In order to receive the additional year(s) award the applicant must maintain good standing in the military, full time enrollment at a technical training program, or at least part time enrollment (defined as at least half of a full time student) at a college or university. Applicants must also keep the scholarship chair informed of any change of addresses during the applications eligibility for future awards. It is the responsibility of the award winner to keep the chair and or organization informed of their progress and their qualifying for future year's awards. As CASCWA is a nonprofit organization future awards are based upon available funding of the organization. If funding is not available future year's awards will not be distributed. Additional information on subsequent years funding will be provided to the successful applicants.

Our scholarship is called the "Anthony Brucia Success Award," named after the beloved, deceased son of one of our Board members. The award is intended for resilient pupils who have made a turnaround in their lives. The kind of pupil we want to recognize and honor is the pupil who most likely did <u>not</u> have a 4.0+ throughout high school. We're looking for a student who has had to overcome lack of success early on or who had to struggle to maintain academic progress due to a variety of reasons, including but not limited to personal or family stress or problems. We want to acknowledge and support pupils who may have been burdened by "at risk" circumstances and/or may have "hit bottom" but are now putting things back together and show future promise.
