





# STUDENT PERSPECTIVE – The Ace Of Aces: The Red Baron

Manfred von Richthofen, better known as the Red Baron, was a famous and respected fighter pilot of WW1. Manfred was once a cavalryman before he joined the Air Service and became one of the first members of a fighter squadron in 1915. During 1917 he led a special squadron known as The Flying Circus. It is named that because

of the bright red paint job on their planes, but also they move from place to place setting up tents near airfields. In late 1917 Manfred received the "Blue Max", Prussia's highest military honor. Manfred was buried by Australian officers with full military honors.

- 3. Counseling / Advising with Student Educational Plan: March
